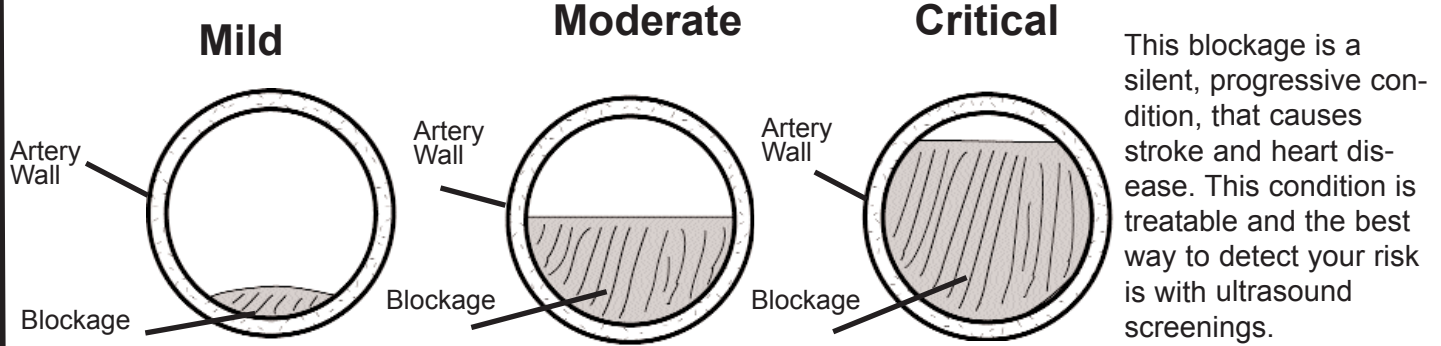

## Artery Blockage



### Stroke Screening

This screening visualizes the buildup of fatty blockage in the carotid arteries. This condition causes the majority of strokes.

### AAA Screening

This screening visualizes the existence of an aneurysm in the abdominal aorta that can rupture and be fatal.

### PAD Screening

This screening checks for blockage in the legs. Abnormal results indicate high risk of coronary artery disease and peripheral arterial disease.

### Hematology Panel

This test screens for abnormally high or low blood cell counts that may indicate the presence of many forms of disease.

### Chemistry Panel

This test measures the health of your vital organs and over all blood health. This is an essential test that is typically requested by your doctor as a part of a routine check-up. It gives you and your doctor a clearer picture of your overall health.

### PSA Screening

This test screens for prostate cancer by testing the level of PSA in the blood.

### Thyroid Test

This test screens for thyroid disease. Signs often include weakness, dry skin, coarse hair, cold intolerance, constipation, weight gain, muscle cramps, hoarseness.

### Hemoglobin A1C

The A1C test gives you a picture of your average blood glucose (blood sugar) control for the past 2 to 3 months.

### HS CRP

This test is used to evaluate your risk of developing coronary artery disease, a condition in which the arteries of your heart are narrowed. Coronary artery disease can eventually lead to a heart attack.

### Vitamin D

This test is used to screen for or monitor bone disorders. Also used to check levels in people with chronic illnesses and certain autoimmune diseases.

### Atrial Fibrillation Screening

The electrocardiogram monitors the electrical activity of the heart. Abnormal EKG waves can show a heart rate that is too fast, slow, or irregular. Atrial fibrillation (AF) is the most common cardiac arrhythmia.
